Through this lecture, we aim to broaden the outreach of the School in London and raise funds for its activities in Greece. **The lecture will take place at the British Academy on 22nd January 2014.**

The recent publication of Professor Broodbank's book adds a further dimension to regional studies of the Mediterranean past, taking the story back to its beginnings and considering the African shore in detail as well as more widely studied regions. Copies of this handsomely illustrated book, published by Thames & Hudson, will be available for purchase at a concessionary price and the lecture will be followed by a book signing and reception.
