### **Politics, Power and Ideology on the Cretan Mountains during the Proto- and Neo-palatial Periods: New Evidence from the Ierapetra Uplands**

This presentation deals with the results of the archaeological investigations of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens on the uplands of Ierapetra, East Crete. Excavations in the mountain building at Gaidourophas and in the peak sanctuaries at Stavromenos and Pantotinou Koryphi, and surface survey of the surrounding area between the modern villages of Anatoli, Kalamafka and Kroustas have provided new evidence concerning the special conditions of life on the mountains, the exploitation of mountain resources and, overall, the importance of the upland areas for Minoan economy and life, particularly in the Proto- and Neo-palatial periods (1900-1450 BCE).
