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A GUIDE TO THE STRATIGRAPHICAL MUSEUM IN THE PALACE AT KNOSSOS.

Based on the work of Dr. Duncan Mackenzie, assisted by Emm. Akoumianos.

With reference to the formation of a stratigraphical Museum within the Palace, Sir Arthur Evans has supplied the following note :—

“The plan of gradually creating a permanent ‘Reference Museum’ within the Palace was first initiated by me in 1905, the opportunity being offered for it by the roofing over not only of the ‘Room of the Throne’ itself, leaving an available loft under the roof above, but of the corridors and chambers by which it was backed and surrounded. These were at that time fitted for shelves, ‘the baskets from the various floors and levels being carefully arranged on these’ (see Report 1905) ‘and labelled by Dr. Mackenzie.’

In 1913, when Dr. Mackenzie had undertaken the Directorship of the Palestine Exploration Fund and the stratigraphical Museum had to be dealt with by me personally, a special series of exploratory researches was carried out, some summary references to which, amounting to about a hundred, were written by me on wooden labels. It had indeed already become necessary to substitute these for paper owing to the ravages of the small insects known to the Cretans as ψαράκια or ‘little fishes.’

This arrangement of shelves was improved when the Throne Room was roofed over on a better system and the baskets themselves were gradually replaced by open wooden boxes.

A small workroom was also fitted out by me under the Central Staircase of the West Palace Section.

About the same time the restoration of upper floors in the Domestic Quarter provided an additional space in the so-called ‘Lair,’ which was now fitted out in the same way. The roofing over of the ‘Shrine’ and adjoining Chamber in the ‘Little Palace’ provided in its turn an extension of the ‘Museum’ for the benefit of that quarter, and as part of the plan for the restoration of the ‘Grand Staircase’ there in 1930–31, a new compartment was built and fitted up under its second landing.

In 1922 Dr. Mackenzie was able to resume his position as my assistant at Knossos, but unfortunately, owing to his continued ill-health, little progress could be made with the ‘Palace Museum.’ It is therefore a subject of sincere congratulation that the large arrears have now been successfully dealt with on

an improved system by Mr. Pendlebury. The materials indeed have been greatly augmented by the results of the campaigns of 1930 and 1931."

At the beginning of the excavations the sherds from the various strata were housed in baskets with wooden labels attached giving their provenance and depth. Owing to the enormous mass of more important material resulting from the yearly continuation of the excavations, the task of housing the sherds more permanently was not begun until 1922.

By that time a few of the labels had become illegible owing to the attentions of ψαράκια, and the task had been begun of changing over the sherds into wooden boxes and inscribing the details on the boxes in blue pencil. This work was finally completed in the summer of 1931. In addition to the description of the spot whence the sherds came it was found advisable to give each separate place a key-number in red on the bottom left-hand corner of the box. Specially enlarged plans were then prepared and numbered in accordance. Thanks to the extraordinary ability of the foreman, Emmanuelis Akoumianos, whose phenomenal memory enabled him to place definitely a large number of un-inscribed boxes and whose own detailed plans, numbered in accordance with a system of his own, enabled many boxes to be safely attributed to a particular slab or fragment of stone, there remain unidentified only some fifty boxes out of the whole two thousand surviving, while the rest, allowing for the gaps caused by the loss of labels when a large number of baskets were transported to the Museum in 1905, cover the whole Palace area as well as the houses and tombs round about.

The numbered plans are kept by the foreman in his office. The order in

the catalogue is as follows:—Serial Number; Description of Place; Vertical Divisions, if any, with number of boxes to each; Total Number of Boxes; Year of Excavation.

It will be noticed that many titles display unfamiliar names. These descend from the early days of the dig, though there is no example of the title 'The Great Tank' for the Grand Staircase. In all these cases I give the modern equivalent.

It is hoped some day to complete the gigantic task of publishing the details and dating of the pottery in each box; it has indeed already been begun. Meanwhile this guide may be of some assistance to those wishing to study it for themselves. But I should be very much obliged if anyone who has been through any of the boxes would inform me of their contents, since in this way the final publication will be considerably hastened. It is proposed to issue details of dating every year to those who wish to keep their copy up to date.

In the store-room north of the Throne Room, in the first compartment, is a complete Type Series of sherds from every period. As far as possible these typical sherds have been taken from the fifty odd boxes whose provenance is unknown. Besides the boxes containing the Neolithic and Minoan sherds are those containing Protogeometric, Geometric, Hellenic, Hellenistic and Roman. This Type Series should provide a sound basis for anyone wishing to begin the study of Minoan Pottery.

B. I. THE WEST COURT (West Square).

In the following section Numbers 4 to 18 inclusive should really be included in the section B. III., since they are rooms in the earlier houses lying to the East of the North-West Acropolis Houses, and probably belong to the same system as the rooms B. III. 8 and 9. The plan, however, which gave their exact position was only discovered after they had been assigned their numbers and after those numbers had been inscribed on the special plan. It therefore seemed best to leave them where they are. They will, however, be found marked not only on the big plan of the Palace but also on the separate plan of the North-West Acropolis Houses.
