Late Bronze Age archaeology of the island of Kefalonia in the 21st century: From culture history to hermeneutics



Summary:

The island of Kefalonia, the largest of the Ionian Islands, off the west coast of Greece, has been the subject of archaeological investigations for well over a century. In the last twenty years, archaeological activity by the Greek archaeological service, universities and individual researchers has added considerably, but often incompletely, to our knowledge of the island in the Bronze Age. The talk will look briefly at the fieldwork undertaken during this time, including the speaker's own work for the *Livatho Valley Survey* (LVS) (2003-2013), and will discuss thematically the levels of interpretation that can be achieved, from both old and new finds, for the understanding of Late Bronze Age island societies.
